एतद् द्वारा सूचित किया जाता है कि जय प्रकाश विश्वविद्यालय, छपरा के क्षेत्रान्तर्गत सभी सम्बद्ध बी०एड० महाविद्यालयों में द्विवर्षीय बी०एड० पाठ्यक्रम सत्र (2017-2019) में नामांकन हेतु कुलाधिपति सचिवालय के निदेशानुसार (पत्रांक BSU Regulation -2015/1283/GS (1) dated 02.09.2015) विश्वविद्यालय स्तर पर Combined Entrance Test (CET) सामान्य प्रवेश परीक्षा निम्नांकित तिथियों के अनुसार आयोजित की जायेगी।

आवेदन प्राप्ति की तिथि : 24th June 2017

प्रवेश परीक्षा की तिथि : 9th July 2017

नामांकन हेतु Ordinance विश्वविद्यालय के Web site www.jpv.bih.nic.in पर छात्र Application form भरने के पहले अवश्य पढ़ लें। इस विश्वविद्यालय के अन्तर्गत पन्द्रह स्ववित्तपोषित B.Ed. College हैं जिनके नाम, स्थापना का वर्ष एवं नामांकन हेतु उपलब्ध सीटों की संख्या दी गई है।

CET में उत्तीर्ण छात्रों का ही नामांकन B.Ed. Course में हो पायेगा। किसी भी महाविद्यालय को अपने स्तर पर नामांकन की अनुमति नहीं दी गई है। अगर कोई भी महाविद्यालय अपने स्तर पर नामांकन लेता है तो इसकी सारी जिम्मेवारी उस महाविद्यालय के प्राचार्य एवं सचिव की होगी तथा विश्वविद्यालय किसी भी स्थिति में ऐसे छात्रों का पंजीकरण और परीक्षा लेने के लिए वाध्य नहीं होगा। विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा आयोजित होने वाली प्रवेश परीक्षा से इतर प्रवेश लेने वाले दोषी महाविद्यालयों का संबंधन स्थाई रूप से समाप्त कर दिया जायेगा।

आवेदन की एक छायाप्रति एवं 1000/-रु० का Demand Draft जो कुलसचिव जय प्रकाश विश्वविद्यालय के नाम पर भुगतये हो, के साथ विश्वविद्यालय परीक्षा विभाग में जमा करेंगे।

Combined Entrance Test परीक्षा चार Paper को होगी। प्रत्येक Paper में 50 objective Questions होंगे। प्रत्येक प्रश्न 2 Marks का होगा। इस प्रकार यह प्रवेश परीक्षा कुल 400 अंकों की होगी तथा एक ही दिन में आयोजित होगी। प्रश्न पत्र 1 एवं 2 के बीच आधे घंटे का अन्तराल रहेगा। प्रश्न पत्र के बाद 2 घंटे का अन्तराल रहेगा। पुनः प्रश्न पत्र 3 और प्रश्न पत्र 4 के बीच आधे घण्टे का अन्तराल रहेगा।

1. General Knowledge : 50 x 2 = 100 marks
 2. Aptitude Test : 50 x 2 = 100 marks
 3. Languages : 50 x 2 = 100 marks
 4. Subject Groups (Science / Arts & Commerce) : 50 x 2 = 100 marks
- Total Time 4 hrs. रहेगा (1hr/paper)।

ORDINANCE FOR ADMISSION

1. Admission and Selection Procedure

- 1.1 The selection of candidates for admission to the Bachelor of Education programme (B. Ed) in Regular mode shall be made on the basis of merit obtained in B.Ed. Entrance Test conducted by the respective University on charge of approved Entrance Test fee of Rs. 1000/-
- 1.2 The Entrance Test fee may be revised by the competent authority as and when required.
- 1.3 Admission shall be made strictly in order of merit i.e. percentage of marks secured by the candidate at the B.Ed. Entrance Test held for the purpose.
- 1.4 Reservation of seats for the candidates of reserved categories shall be as per State Government's rules.
- 1.5 There of 3% seats will be reserved for Person with Disability (PWD) candidates i.e. Visually Impaired (1%), Hearing Impaired (1%) & Orthopedically Handicapped (1%). These 3% seats are within the intake limit. Percentage of disability will be taken into consideration at the time of selection. The 3% seats of PWD candidates shall be filled up within the seat limit fixed for that particular category to which the PWD candidates belong to.
- 1.6 Appearance in the Entrance Test is mandatory. The reserved category candidates shall have to submit a copy of the certificate mentioning that the candidate belongs to a particular reserved category from an officer not below the rank of S.D.M.
- 1.7 Joint B.Ed. Entrance Test will be conducted centrally by the University. Date of B.Ed. Entrance Test will be announced by the University and merit list will also be prepared by the University after evaluation of answer books.
Admission-merit list shall be prepared by the respective University, and seat allotment will be done through Counseling.
- 1.8 List of admitted students must be submitted to the University within one month after declaration of merit list.
- 1.9 Reservation of seats provided in the general ordinance for admission shall be applicable only when candidate fulfills the minimum requirements of clause- 1.3
- 1.10 After providing the opportunity for admission to the candidates having descending orders of merit of lower qualification up to the marks fixed by the respective University, if the reservation percentage of any reserved category is not filled up shall be exchanged as per State Govt. rules.
- 1.11 If at any time is found that candidate has furnished any false information, his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately and the deposited fee shall be forfeited and suitable legal action may be initiated.
- 1.12 In case of any controversy of irregularity pertaining to 2 year B.Ed. course, the respective University shall take the final decision as per approved Ordinance and Regulations.

1.13 No such applicant shall be admitted, who in the opinion of Vice-Chancellor, does not deserve to be admitted in the best interest of the University, (specifying the ground for rejection)

2. Eligibility

2.1 The candidate with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and in the Master's Degree in Science /Social Science/Humanity/Commerce Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks of any other qualification/examination recognized by the Academic Council of respective University equivalent there to be eligible for admission to the programme.

2.2 No such applicant shall be admitted, who has not applied for the admission within notified time or who, on being selected for admission, does not get himself/herself admitted within specified time, except where the delay has been condoned by the competent authority for some valid reason.

3. Intake

There shall be basic unit of 50 students, with a maximum of two units. This intake capacity may be modified as per norms and guidelines prescribed by NCTE time- to- time.

4. Fee

4.1 The fee structure for the two year B.Ed. course is recommended to be as follows:
