Guidelines for Submission of Thesis/ Dissertation for Anti-Plagiarism Check

Notwithstanding the University's Ph.D. ordinance for submission of thesis/dissertation, the guidelines prescribed in this document entitled "Guidelines for Submission of Thesis / Dissertation)" are guidelines for submission of Ph.D. Thesis/ Dissertation. Guidelines have been revised in accordance with the UGC Notification (Minimum Standards & Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree, Regulation, 2009) dated 11th July, 2009; and, subsequent approval of Jai Prakash University Academic Council.

Submission of Thesis/Dissertation for anti-plagiarism check

The following documents to be submitted at the Jai Prakash University, Technical Committee for Plagiarism Test (TCPT):

1. Research Scholars shall submit one printed copy (Spiral bound) of the thesis/dissertation as per the Ph.D. regulation of the Jai Prakash University vide Memo No- C/1455 dated 22/12/2012.

The final thesis shall be presented in accordance with the following specifications:

- i. The paper used for printing shall be of good quality A -4 size paper.
- ii. Printing shall be in a standardized form on both the sides of the paper and in 1.5 spacing.
- iii. A margin of about 2.5 cm shall be on all sides excluding the margin required for binding
- iv. For document of Hindi, Sanskrit, and other Indian languages, the types text should be UNICODE compliant. No analysis will be performed for such documents. Google input tool supports typing on Indian language text in Unicode compliant format.
- v. The front cover and back cover should be of cardboard of reasonable thickness.
- vi. The Title of the thesis, name of the candidate, degree, Name of the Supervisor, place of research with seal and the month and year of submission shall be printed on the Title page and the front cover.

- vii. The spine of the thesis should mention Ph. D. Thesis on the top, Name of the Candidate, Title and Month and Year.
2. One CD containing the whole thesis as a single file in PDF/DOC/DOCX/ODT format along with the requisite fee of Rs. 500/ -. In case the limit of plagiarism exceeds the prescribed level and the same candidate applies for second and/or third time he/she has to deposit the requisite fee again. Fee for 1sttime anti plagiarism check: Rs. 500/ - only Fee for 2ndtime anti plagiarism check: Rs. 500/ - only Fee for 3rdtime anti plagiarism check: Rs. 500/ -only
